 - a. In the life of a Christian, what is the primary factor in determining the kinds of fruit (attitudes, actions, words) that will be produced in life?
 - a. Read Galatians 5:22-23. When you think about your life, what kind of fruit do you want to produce? What can you do to ensure that you are producing the fruit you desire?

 - B. Who is the vinedresser? What does the vinedresser do to care for and provide for the vineyard? Read John 15:2.
 - C. How has God provided for and cared for you?
 - D. Have you ever undergone the pruning process so that you can produce more fruit? Was that process painful?
 - E. Was the result worth undergoing the pruning process?
